

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. ZONE 4 CHAMPIONSHIP: A PRINT OUT OF THE LAST 20 SCORES (13 OF WHICH MUST BE IN THE CURRENT YEAR) MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM FOR ALL COMPETITORS WISHING TO PLAY IN THE ZONE 4 CHAMPIONSHIP. ANY PLAYER WHO SCORED HIGHER THAN 13 STROKES OVER THE COURSE RATING AT LAST YEAR'S QUALIFYING EVENT AT KINGS LINKS MAY HAVE THEIR ENTRY DENIED.**
- 2. JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS: A PRINTOUT OF YOUR LAST 20 SCORES MUST ACCOMPANY THIS ENTRY FORM.**
3. It is the responsibility of the players to advise the BCGA Zone 4 Inter Club Golf Committee of a reduction in their handicap factor prior to the deadline date in the event of the tournament being over subscribed. The **B.C.G.A. MEMBERSHIP CARD MUST BE PRESENTED FOR INSPECTION AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION AT ALL EVENTS.** Selection to teams representing the ZONE in the B.C. Championships is only open to players who have been a B.C. resident in ZONE 4 for a period of three months and have been residing in Canada for one year. **BCGA MEMBERSHIP CARDS ARE REQUIRED TO BE CURRENT AND PRESENTED FOR INSPECTION AT THE REGISTRATION TABLE FOR ALL EVENTS.**
- 4. POWER CARTS:** Competitors are not permitted to ride power carts during any Championship competition EXCEPT the Senior Championship. They may be used in all other Inter-Club events except Junior events.
- 5. AMATEUR STATUS:** Competitors that have breached their amateur status as defined under the rules laid down by the Royal Canadian Golf Association are ineligible to compete in any BCGA or Zone 4 Inter-Club Golf Committee events.
- 6. GENERAL RULINGS AND CONDITIONS OF PLAY** in the Zone 4 Championship events will be provided to all competitors at the registration table.
- 7. WITHDRAWALS:** A competitor withdrawing during the course of the event must immediately notify the Tournament Chairman of the reason for such action. The reason must be on medical or compassionate grounds acceptable to the Tournament Chairman. Failure to do so will result in automatic suspension of the privilege to play in ALL of next year's events sanctioned or conducted by the Zone 4 Inter-club Golf Committee. **A NO-SHOW MAY BE DEEMED AN UNAUTHORIZED WITHDRAWAL.**

CONTESTANT WAIVER - The applicant is aware of and assumes all risks of bodily injury or property damage including specifically (but not exclusively) the risk of being injured by thrown or struck golf balls or clubs, actions by spectators, players, caddies or others in attendance, and the competitor agrees that the BCGA Zone 4 Inter-Club Golf Committee, including its Directors, Officers, and employees, are not liable for any injuries resulting from such causes or any other negligence. I have read the entry information and the contestant waiver and will abide by them, and I agree that the acceptance of this entry is subject to approval of the BCGA Zone 4 Inter-Club Golf Committee at their sole discretion. I confirm that to the best of my knowledge, I am not in breach of any of the Rules of Amateur Status laid down by the Royal Canadian Golf Association.
