1. CALL TO ORDER: 10:30 AM

Chairperson, Gail Thurston called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. There was a quorum.

3. INTRODUCTION OF MEMBERS/EXECUTIVE

All the attendees from each Club and the Executive introduced themselves.

4. ADOPTION OF MINUTES – March 2025

Motion to approve the minutes of the 2025 Spring Zone 3-4 meeting minutes as circulated.

5. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE SPRING MINUTES

There was a lively discussion about the continuation of the annual year-end Zone tournament. There was concern by Mylora as to whether they would be able to host a tournament due to its club size with several members making suggestions, such as setting an amount aside each year and getting club members to donate prizes. At the end, with so many changes, it would be nice to carry on this tradition of having a year-end tournament.



6. REPORTS:

Chairperson's report:

Gail reported that she attended all the meetings except the Zone 3.

Treasurer's report:

Current Bank Balance, \$668.81 as at Oct 31 2025. Still two outstanding expenses to come before year end for meeting costs and bank fee.

Bank balance should then be approximately \$549.00 for year end. Motion to approve the financial report as distributed accepted.

2025 Zone 3-4 Tournament Report – Greenacres Golf Club, Joanne Dorman

Joanne provided a written recap of the tournament as follows:

The tournament this year was hosted by Greenacres Monday Women's Golf Club. It was held on Sunday, August 26th at Greenacres Golf Club.

The format that was implemented in 2019 was followed. A total of 32 golfers participated – 4 members from each club along with the 2024 Low Gross winner, 2024 Low Net winner, Zone 3-4 Chair and Greenacres Club Captain.

The prizing that was in place for the past 2 years was followed, a total of \$1,550 for Gross and Net along with Long Drive and KP.

Our members were very supportive and generous in their contributions towards the Tournament allowing the Committee to put together 18 door prize baskets.

There was a 50/50 draw. The proceeds of this along with the Deuce Pot were donated to BC Juniors Girl's Golf.

The winners were:

Team of the Year – Frasersview

Team of the Day – Tsawwassen Springs

Low Gross – Kari Yuers, Tsawwassen Springs

Low Net – Chris Gervais, Tsawwassen Springs

It was a fun filled day of golf followed by a buffet lunch, trophy presentation and prizes for low gross and low net.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

Tournament Rotation

Surrey will be hosting the 2026 Tournament. Marlene Proc reported that the date will be August 16, 2026, a committee has been formed to organize the tournament and she will be getting a rules person.

Tournament Trophies

Joanne Dorman presented the following the Zone issues with the 3-4 Tournament Trophies.

1. Low Net Trophy: covers the years 2006 to 2025 with the 2025 recognition plaque mounted on the top of the wood base.
2. Low Gross Trophy: covers the years 2006 to 2025. There is no room for any more recognition plaques.
3. Team of the Day: covers the years 2006 to 2025. There is no room for any more recognition plaques.
4. Team of the Year: covers the years 2006 to 2025. This trophy has had a further base added. There is room for 8 more recognition plaques.

Do we consider adding a base to the existing trophies that are full? I spoke with Brad at Tidey's Trophies and the cost for this would be approximately \$200 to \$250.

Alternatively, these 3 trophies could be retired and replaced with a wooden or synthetic plaque that would hold 15 recognition plaques. The cost would be approximately \$200 for the wooden one and approximately \$250 for the synthetic one.

Tournament "Seed" Money - \$600

With the Zone 3-4 Tournament's new format, all clubs can now host the tournament at their home courses. It is my understanding that this \$600 was put into place to assist clubs to have funds in the event deposits were necessary for the tournament.

For the most part, I don't see that this is required with the current tournament format, perhaps this money can be given back to the Zone 3-4 Business Women's Golf Association and used to assist with our trophy situation.

Motion by Gina Henry to use the \$600 to pay for the trophies. Seconded by Ciara Martin. Motion passed 100%.
