At the Team 1 level, our public Zone 4 clubs compete with Zone 3, and have done so for years as we do not have many clubs with a Team 1. This year the clubs with a Team 1 have been Burnaby Mountain, Fraserview, University and the Vancouver Chinese Ladies. However, Burnaby Mountain has given notice that they intend to withdraw from Team 1, leaving only three clubs in Zone 4 with a Team 1.

We discussed the issues of Team 1 this spring at our general meeting, and the "host pays" system of green fees, the difficulty in mounting three teams, the handicap indexes and travel distances have all been identified as important issues.
